
2021 Foundation enrolments close on Friday 31st July 2020.

On Tuesday the 12th of May I participated in a Girls in S.T.E.M workshop: To pop or not. Over Zoom we all did lots of experiments that would either pop or not. Three of them were ways to blow up a balloon using a chemical reaction with bi-carb soda, vinegar, soft drink, yeast, water and sugar. Although my yeast experiment failed my bi -carb soda experiment work every well.

We also learnt about how a balloon pops and how to prevent it. We found out that if water is in the inside of a blown up balloon and fire beneath it the water pretexts the balloon.

Alissa showed us an experiment with a nail board and balloons. If the presser was spaced evenly then the balloon wouldn't pop. That was lots of fun to watch!

Another of the experiments we did was allowing a pencil or skewer to pass through a zip lock bag full of water without any spilling.
