Changes in DET guidelines, review of expenses for our families, OH&S requirements and revised staffing levels, supported the decision to operate camps on a bi—annual basis at BVSPS. All students will still be offered two camping experiences whilst in Grade 3-6. This change has been discussed and approved by School Council also. I thank families for their understanding with this difficult decision. This means that there will not be any camps scheduled for 2022, returning again in 2023!

2022 Grade transition activities for 2022:









Foundation Lowe Term 4: Maths and Literacy
